Dr. Maron is Chief of the Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery section of Children's Healthcare of Atlanta at Scottish Rite. He also has a clinical appointment at Emory University, Grady Hospital and Crawford W. Long Memorial Hospital. He is an Assistant Clinical Professor at Emory University. He has active hospital appointment at Emory University Hospital Midtown, Grady, Saint Joseph Hospital, and Children's Healthcare at Scottish Rite and Egleston. He is a consultant on staff at VA Medical Center.

Dr. Maron was the official Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeon for the 1996 Olympic games in Atlanta. He was also the maxillofacial surgeon for the Atlanta Thrashers hockey club, and continues to work with the Atlanta Falcons football team, Atlanta Hawks and the Atlanta Braves baseball team. He is a consultant for the Emory University athletic department. Dr. Maron also lectures nationally for KLS Martin in the field of Reconstructive Maxillofacial Surgery. Dr. Maron has been named maxillo-facial consultant for the NHL and is immediate past president of the Georgia Society of Oral and Maxillofacial surgery.
