

1. **TITLE:** Oral Path: Love it or Hate it, Recognize it!
2. **DESCRIPTION:** The course will cover a spectrum of the most common and significant lesions in oral pathology including red and white lesions, ulcerative conditions, lumps and bumps, infections and radiographic pathology. Numerous clinical images will be provided to give the clinician a thorough review of the selected topics. The instructor will review appropriate therapy and management suggestions of these lesions.
